

Bible Reading for Week of December 1, 2024

Monday, December 2 – Matthew 11: 25-30

What does it mean that your God is both Father and Lord of heaven and earth? How does the Father relate to the Son? Why is the Son able to give you rest? Today make yourself like a little child and learn from the one who is gentle and lowly.

Tuesday, December 3 – Numbers 20: 1-13

What does grumbling sound like? Why is grumbling incredibly shortsighted? (Exodus 16, Numbers 11) How does Moses too fail to believe in the Lord? When you are in the wilderness of life look to Jesus who is your rock and believe.

Wednesday, December 4 – 2 Corinthians 9: 6-15

A thankful attitude permeates your entire life. What are the fruits of thanksgiving? Specifically, how does generosity increase your gratitude? (v. 12) Thanks be to God for His inexpressible gift!

Thursday, December 5 – Matthew 1: 18-25

How did Joseph demonstrate a merciful and generous heart? What would this have cost him socially? How does God demonstrate His merciful and generous heart? Why did he choose to reveal himself in this humble way? As you reflect on Jesus' coming, remember that truly God is with us.

Friday, December 6 – Isaiah 54: 4-8

How does Jesus fulfill the passage? What does this mean for you? Consider the fact that the infant born of a virgin is your husband and redeemer. Claim those promises today.

Saturday, December 7 – Psalm 138: 1-6

Give praise to the Lord with your whole heart! Remember that He regards the humble who sing His praises.
