

Bible Reading for the Week of February 1, 2026

Monday, February 2 – Joel 2:12-27

According to verses 12-13, what does true repentance look like? What might it look like for someone to "*rend their heart*" (vs. 13)? How often is repentance a part of your Christian life? Consider ways that you might repent of specific sins before the Lord today

Tuesday, February 3 – Joel 2:12-27

What is the encouragement that Joel provides the people of Israel with if they turn to the Lord in repentance? How might the mercy and grace of God promote greater levels of repentance in you? Take time today to praise the Lord that he is a God full of mercy and grace.

Wednesday, February 4 – Joel 2:12-27

How does the Lord respond to the people's cries for mercy in verses 18-27? How might verse 25 be specifically applicable to true believers today? As you pray today, be sure to praise the Lord that he can restore to you the wasted years of life in ways you cannot imagine

Thursday, February 5 – 2 Peter 1:12-15

Why is it important for Peter to remind the church of truths they already know? How can Christians grow forgetful in their life? As you pray today, be sure to ask the Lord to help you remember the truths of his word concerning him, his world, and you

Friday, February 6 – 2 Peter 1:12-15

To what event recorded in the Gospels does Peter likely refer in verse 14? How might Jesus' words to Peter in John 21 influenced his life moving forward? How should our future death shape how we live now? Pray that the Lord would enable you to serve him well with the time he has given you on this earth.

Saturday, February 7 – 2 Peter 1:12-15

In light of verse 15, what might be one way Peter helped the church to remember these things? How has that means of remembrance been preserved for us? Take time today to give thanks to the Lord for preserving his word for us so that we might be reminded of the truths of the gospel.
