

## Bible Reading for the Week of February 15, 2026

### Monday, February 16 – Joel 2:28-32

What is the blessing which the Lord promises to bestow upon his people? Does this future blessing of the Spirit differ in any way from the Spirit's activity in the Old Testament? If so, how? Give thanks to the Lord today for the wonderful gift of his Spirit to the church.

### Tuesday, February 17 – Joel 2:28-32 and Numbers 11:24-30

How might this prophecy concerning the Spirit relate to Number 11:24-30 (see especially vs. 29)? In what way does the prophecy in Joel relate to Moses's desire? How is Moses's desire fulfilled in the work of the Lord Jesus and the gift of his Spirit? As you pray today, take time to ask that this same Spirit would further sanctify you in conformity to Jesus Christ.

### Wednesday, February 18 – Joel 2:28-32 and Acts 2:14-41

How does the Joel 2 passage relate to Peter's Pentecost sermon? What role does the ascension of Christ play in the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy? How does the pouring out of the Spirit impact the church moving forward? Pray that this same Spirit would embolden you so that you might walk faithfully in this world.

### Thursday, February 19 – 2 Peter 1:16-21

What event does Peter refer to in verses 16-18? How does the transfiguration event relate to Peter's greater argument? How is the apostolic witness "*more fully confirmed*" in light of the transfiguration (vs. 19)? Thank the Lord today for the sure word of the apostles written down for our instruction.

### Friday, February 20 – 2 Peter 1:16-21

According to the apostle Peter, how is the Spirit active in the work of men writing Scripture? In what way is the Holy Spirit the author of the Bible? In what way are the men who wrote the Bible the authors of it? Praise the Lord for giving to us his very word, the Bible.

### Saturday, February 21 – 2 Peter 1:16-21

How does the Spirit's inspiration of the Scripture relate to our lives today? Is the Spirit's inspiration of the writers of Scripture the same as his illumination of our minds and hearts as we read the word? How do they differ? As you prepare to worship the Lord tomorrow with his people, pray that the Spirit would enable you to not only be a hearer of the word, but also a doer.
