

Bible Reading for the Week of March 1, 2026

Monday, March 2 – Joel 3:1-16

What might this passage ultimately be describing in light of our understanding of the day of the Lord? Where is the only place to find refuge when this war begins (vs. 16)? Pray that the Lord would help you to find refuge in him each and every day.

Tuesday, March 3 – Joel 3:17-21

Why might it be significant that "*strangers shall never again pass through [God's dwelling place]*" (vs. 17)? Why would holiness be necessary for people to dwell with God? How does this relate to the Spirit's work in our lives? Pray that the Lord would sanctify you more and more by his Spirit.

Wednesday, March 4 – Joel 3:17-21

What are the twin results that Joel finishes the prophecy with? How does this principle of salvation and judgment play itself out through the whole of the Bible? Praise the Lord this morning that in Jesus Christ there is salvation for sinners!

Thursday, March 5 – 2 Peter 2:10-22

What are some of the characteristics of the false teachers, according to verses 10-12? How might this despising of authority (vs. 10) manifest itself in the church? Take time throughout the coming days to ask that the Lord would preserve his church from the presence of false teachers.

Friday, March 6 – 2 Peter 2:10-22

What does Peter identify as being one of the chief characteristics of false teachers in verses 13-16? How does the story of Balaam in Numbers 22-23 demonstrate the presence of greed, according to Peter? How might this greed in false teachers express itself in the life of the church? Continue to pray that the Lord would protect his church from false teaching.

Saturday, March 6 – 2 Peter 2:10-22

How is the state of the false teachers worse than an unbeliever outside the church? What does this say about the seriousness of being a member of the church? Do you view your church membership as a weighty matter? As you prepare to worship the Lord tomorrow, take time to pray that the Lord would use the corporate gathering for worship to glorify his name and build you up in faith.
