

## Bible Reading for the Week of March 22, 2026

### Monday, March 23 – John 1:12-13

According to the apostle John, what things are necessary in order for someone to become a child of God? How does belief in Christ further clarify what it means to receive him? Praise the Lord today for welcoming you into his family through the work of the Lord Jesus, *the* Son of God.

### Tuesday, March 24 – John 1:12-13

How does verse 13 rule out any effort or participation in our becoming Christians? How does an overemphasis on man's "free will" rob God of his glory in the giving of salvation? Be sure to take time throughout the day to thank the Lord for giving you life in the Son.

### Wednesday, March 25– Romans 8:12-17

What is the role of the Spirit of God in our adoption into the family of God? How does the Spirit serve as confirmation that we are the children of God? What is the expected life pattern for sons of God, according to the apostle Paul in verse 17? Pray for the Spirit's continued leading in your spiritual walk.

### Thursday, March 26 – 2 Peter 3:14-18

What are the things that Peter calls the church to as we wait for the new heavens and the new earth (vs. 14)? Why are holiness and peace so important in the life of the people of God? What are some of the reasons why a church might lack holiness and peace? Take time today to ask the Lord that he would work both of these things out in our church.

### Friday, March 27 – 2 Peter 3:14-18

How does Peter view the writings of the apostle Paul? How does this strengthen our view of Old *and* New Testaments? Praise the Lord today for giving us his inspired, infallible, and inerrant word.

### Saturday, March 28– 2 Peter 3:14-18

Peter concludes this epistle with a charge to refrain from certain things and embrace other things. What should we refrain from (vs. 17)? What should we embrace (vs. 18)? How do we "*grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ*" (vs. 18)? As you prepare to worship the Lord tomorrow, pray that He might give you a mind to understand the truth and a heart to embrace the truth.
