

## **Bible Reading for the Week of March 29, 2026**

### **Monday, March 30 – John 1:14-18**

Take time to reflect on the movement throughout the prologue and its relation to verse 14. What makes the incarnation so significant? Why is the incarnation necessary for us? Take time today to praise the Lord for sending his son to this earth so that we might have life through him.

### **Tuesday, March 31 – John 1:14-18**

How does Jesus's ministry relate to that of Moses? How are these eras in redemptive-history similar? How are they different? Praise the Lord today that we have the wonderful privilege of knowing Christ savingly.

### **Wednesday, April 1– John 1:14-18**

According to verse 18, what does the Son do with respect to the Father? How does Jesus reveal to us what God is like? Give thanks to God today that he has given you eyes to see his glory in Jesus Christ.

### **Thursday, April 2 – Isaiah 65:17-25**

What does Isaiah envision the new heavens and new earth being like? How would these features have been particularly impactful for those living in the days before the exile? In your prayers today, ask that the Lord would cultivate in you a desire for heaven.

### **Friday, April 3 – Isaiah 66:15-24**

What are some of the features of the new heavens and new earth that Isaiah lists in this final section? How does worship play a prominent role in the life of the age to come? How should this reality impact our lives in the present age? Give thanks to the Lord for the wonderful privilege of worshipping him each week.

### **Saturday, April 4 – Revelation 21:1-8**

John records a number of things about the new heavens and new earth that will be true for the people of God. How might those serve to bring hope in the midst of present turmoil and suffering? Ask the Lord to prepare your heart to worship him tomorrow.
