

## **Bible Reading for the Week of March 8, 2026**

### **Monday, March 9 – John 1:1-4**

Over the course of this year, we will be considering the gospel of John during our morning worship service. As we begin to read and study this book of Scripture, pray that the Lord would bless you as you read it and hear sermons on it.

### **Tuesday, March 10 – John 1:1-4**

How is John alluding back to the opening verses of the Bible? How might this shed light on Genesis 1:1? How might John 1:1 be significant for our doctrine of the Trinity? Praise the Lord this morning for revealing himself to you in his word.

### **Wednesday, March 11 – John 1:1-4**

What is the Son's role in creation? How is he distinguished from everything that has been made, according to John? How might these verses fuel the church's worship of the Lord Jesus? Take time today to give thanks to the Lord for the gift of Christ for us.

### **Thursday, March 12 – 2 Peter 3:1-10**

What is the particular issue of the false teachers that Peter is addressing in these verses? What was the argument being made by the false teachers? How does their disbelief in the second coming lead them to live in sin? Consider ways in which you might be tempted to downplay the second coming of Christ. Take time today to confess those sins to the Lord.

### **Friday, March 13 – 2 Peter 3:1-10**

How does the flood judgment in Genesis serve as a picture and type of the coming judgment on the world? Consider some of the similarities and differences between the flood judgment and the end-time judgment. Give thanks to the Lord today that he knows how to rescue the godly from judgment.

### **Saturday, March 14– 2 Peter 3:1-10**

According to Peter, what is one of the reasons the day of the Lord has not yet come (see vs. 9)? How might this reality fuel the church's witness in the world? How might it spur you on in your Christian life? As you prepare to worship the Lord tomorrow, pray that the Lord would use his worship to grow you and sanctify you.
