

Bible Reading for the Week of May 24, 2026

Monday, May 25 – 1 John 3:1-4

What does John say has resulted from the love of God the Father? How are we made partakers of the grace of adoption? Thank the Lord for bringing you into union with Christ, in whom you have received the status of a son of God.

Tuesday, May 26– 1 John 4:7-11

What is the ultimate expression of the love of God, according to the apostle John? How ought the love of God to manifest itself in our lives as believers? Take time today to ask for the Spirit to be at work in enabling you to love the people of God more and more each day.

Wednesday, May 27 – 1 John 4:12-21

Take time today to meditate on verse 19. Consider some of the ways that Scripture describes God's love for his people? How might this love influence our love? Praise the Lord for his marvelous love toward you.

Thursday, May 28 – Philippians 1:1-11

How does verse 6 provide stability and encouragement for the Christian life? Why is there not a tension between Paul's statement in verse 6 and his desire in verses 9-11? Praise the Lord today for his preserving grace in your life.

Friday, May 29 – Philippians 1:12-18a

What is the reason that the apostle Paul is able to rejoice, according to these verses? Is this surprising to you given the circumstances described in verses 15 and 17? How might this serve as a good example to us in our lives? Pray that the Lord would enable his gospel to continue to spread in our day.

Saturday, May 30 – Philippians 1:18b-23

What is Paul's chief aim and desire in life. How does this religious principle find old testament precedent (see Psalm 73:25-26)? Pray that the Spirit would work this all-consuming passion into your life as well.
