

## Bible Reading for the Week of June 14, 2026

### **Monday, June 15 – Psalm 130:1-8**

What does this Psalm teach us about where we should turn in times of difficulty and trouble? As the hymn puts it, "Have we trials and temptations? Is there trouble anywhere? Take it to the Lord in prayer." Be sure to take your burdens to the Lord today in the name of Christ.

### **Tuesday, June 16 – Psalm 130:1-8**

What is the picture provided by the Psalmist for waiting on the Lord? How is waiting on the Lord tethered to the word of the Lord? Pray that the Lord would grant you hope founded upon his word.

### **Wednesday, June 17 – Psalm 130:1-8**

Having waited on the Lord, the Psalmist eagerly expects redemption from the Lord. How is this redemption pictured in the Old Testament? How is it accomplished in the New Testament? Give thanks to the Lord for Christ's redemption accomplished and applied.

### **Thursday, June 18 – Mark 15:1-15**

What is the significance of the line in the Apostles' Creed that Jesus "suffered under Pontius Pilate"? How were Pilate's actions unjust in this scenario? Praise the Lord today for Christ's humiliation and exaltation for your salvation.

### **Friday, June 19 – Mark 15:16-32**

How does the humanity of Christ play a role in the crucifixion account? What is the significance of the temple curtain being torn in two in verse 38? Spend time today meditating on the death of Christ. Be sure to give thanks to the Lord for the gift of life through Christ's work of redemption.

### **Saturday, June 20 – Mark 15:33-47**

What is the significance of the burial of Jesus with respect to our salvation? How does the burial function in relation to Christ's estate of humiliation? Pray that the Spirit would prepare your heart to worship God tomorrow.
