

## **Bible Reading for the Week of June 21, 2026**

### **Monday, June 22 – John 4:27-45**

Why is the woman's statement in verse 29 so surprising? How might you feel if you had just had your sins exposed to you? How does the woman's response in verse 29 instruct us about the way Jesus spoke with sinners? Give thanks to the Lord today for the gentleness of Jesus Christ.

### **Tuesday, June 23 – John 4:27-45**

How does Jesus clarify in verse 34 concerning the food he had to eat? How does Jesus' work relate to the work he had called the disciples to? How does this relate to the church's ministry today? Pray that Christ, by his Spirit, would accomplish his sovereign purposes in our church.

### **Wednesday, June 24 – John 4:46-54**

Consider the significance of verse 50 with respect to biblical faith. How is faith related to the words of Jesus? Where do we turn to hear and believe in the words of Jesus even though he is now in heaven? Ask that the Spirit would instill in you greater faith for the words of Christ.

### **Thursday, June 25 – Hebrews 12:18-29**

Where is the location of New Covenant worship, according to the author of Hebrews? Do you ever think of this when you gather with the saints each Lord's Day? How can this truth inform and transform our weekly Sabbath worship? Pray that the Spirit would cause you to experience the joys of heaven in worship.

### **Friday, June 26 – Revelation 5:1-14**

Here in chapter five, the apostle John has a vision of the events surrounding the ascension and session of the Lord Jesus. How do the saints in heaven react and respond to these events? How should the heavenly worship that we read of here inform our earthly worship? Give thanks to the Lord today for the immense privilege of worshiping him.

### **Saturday, June 27 – Psalm 147:1-20**

How do the calls to praise form the structure to this psalm? What are the various reasons provided as to why the people of God should give praise to the Lord? What actions of God are highlighted for us in the psalm? Pray that you would know these truths as you contemplate worshiping the Lord tomorrow.
