

Bible Reading for the Week of June 28, 2026

Monday, June 29 – John 4:46-54

How might the father's desperate situation concerning his son play a role in the faith that he exhibits? Can you think of any time in your life when the Lord increased your faith while suffering in some way? Praise the Lord that he is the giver of faith.

Tuesday, June 30 – John 4:46-54

How does the faith of the father influence the whole of his family? How should this impact the way in which Christian fathers think about their task as spiritual leaders? Pray for the husbands and fathers in the church that the Lord would enable them to lead their families well.

Wednesday, July 1 – John 4:46-54

Why might it be significant that John places the story of the Samaritan woman next to Jesus' healing of the official's son? How does this reveal something about the gospel and salvation? Praise the Lord that Christ has come to redeem people from every tribe, and nation, and language, and tongue

Thursday, July 2 – Joshua 9:1-27

What is the role of verse 14 in this story? How has it fared for Israel so far in Joshua when they have or haven't sought counsel from the Lord? How might our lives be negatively impacted when we fail to consult the word of the Lord before decision making? Pray that the Lord would give you wisdom and discernment in your life

Friday, July 3 – Joshua 9:1-27

One of the truths we confess is that God is even able to use sinful actions of men to accomplish his purposes? Can you think of other stories in the Bible where this principle plays out? Have you seen the Lord do this in your own life? How so? Praise the Lord today for his gracious providence in your life.

Saturday, July 4 – Psalm 111:1-10

As you prepare to worship the Lord tomorrow, pray that the Spirit would cause you to delight in the wonderful works of the Lord.
