

Bible Reading for the Week of July 12, 2026

Monday, July 13 – John 5:19-29

How does Jesus relate his own life and ministry to the Father in this section? Why is it so important that we affirm this intimate relationship between the Father and the Son? How do these verses enhance our worship of the Triune God? Thank the Lord for revealing these truths about himself to you.

Tuesday, July 14 – John 5:19-29

In verse 23, Jesus makes an incredible statement regarding one's relationship to God. What is the significance of the Son for one's relationship to the Father? What enables someone to relate to the Father as being under grace rather than under wrath? Consider who in your life needs to come to the Christ, and pray that the Lord would provide opportunities for gospel witness.

Wednesday, July 15 – John 5:19-29

What resurrection does Jesus have in view in verse 25? What about in verse 29? How does one receive the resurrection spoken of in verse 25? When will the resurrection of verse 29 take place? Give thanks to the Lord for the Spirit's work of regeneration in your life.

Thursday, July 16 – Joshua 11:1-23

In looking at verses 1-9, what other biblical events are you reminded you of? How do these verses reveal the power and might of God? Take time in your prayers to thank the Lord for his strength and power to save.

Friday, July 17 – Joshua 11:1-23

Why did the Canaanites pursue Israel in battle, according to verse 20? How does the hardening of the heart by the Lord relate to man's responsibility as a creature? Take time to meditate on and give thanks for God's sovereign ordination of whatsoever comes to pass.

Saturday, July 18 – Psalm 100:1-5

As you prepare to worship God tomorrow with his people, how should we come before him, according to this psalm? Pray that the Spirit would enable you to come into his presence tomorrow with joy and thanksgiving.
