

Bible Reading for the Week of July 19, 2026

Monday, July 20 – John 5:30-47

How does the testimony of John the Baptist relate to the testimony of Jesus? What do the works of Jesus reveal, according to verse 36? Praise the Lord today for the record of Jesus' words and works contained in the Holy Scriptures.

Tuesday, July 21 – John 5:30-47

Why did the Jews misunderstand the Old Testament, according to Jesus? What does Jesus indicate is the governing principle for truly understanding the Old Testament? How should this impact the study of the Old Testament for believers? Give thanks to the Lord for the spiritual eyes to see the Lord Jesus revealed in the pages of both Old and New Testaments.

Wednesday, July 22 – John 5:30-47

Can you think of some of the ways in which the apostles understood Jesus' teaching about a proper understanding of the Old Testament? Which texts of the New Testament letters and epistles come to mind (hint: 1 Corinthians 10)? Pray that the Spirit would continue to help you see and understand the Scriptures through the lens of Christ.

Thursday, July 23 – Joshua 12:1-24

To what passage in the Old Testament is the author referring to in verses 1-6? How have we seen appeals to Moses throughout the book of Joshua? Give thanks to the Lord for his faithfulness to his covenant promises.

Friday, July 24 – Joshua 12:1-24

In what way is Joshua a type of Christ (see Hebrews 4)? How does Christ wage war against his and our enemies? How will Christ achieve complete victory over his enemies at the end of the age? Take time today to pray that the Lord Jesus Christ would come quickly.

Saturday, July 25 – Psalm 136:1-26

Why is it important for Christians to rehearse what God has done in the past? How does this encourage us in our lives moving forward? What attributes of God particularly stand out in this passage? How might these fuel your worship of God tomorrow? Pray that the Spirit would prepare your heart today for the worship of God.
