

## **Bible Reading for the Week of July 26, 2026**

### **Monday, July 27 – John 6:1-15**

What is the miracle described by John here in chapter 6? What other miracles have we seen so far in John's Gospel? What do the miracles serve to demonstrate in the life of Jesus? Praise the Lord for the Scriptures that we can read and of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ.

### **Tuesday, July 28 – John 6:1-15**

Why do you think all of the Gospel writers include Jesus' feeding of the five thousand in their narratives? What about Jesus does this story reveal to us? Take time to recount and give thanks to the Lord for all of the ways he has graciously provided precisely what you need.

### **Wednesday, July 29 – John 6:1-15**

How does this story bring into view themes from the Old Testament? Where in the Old Testament do we find God as the provider and sustainer of his people? Praise the Lord today for the provision he has made to nourish your soul through the Lord Jesus Christ.

### **Thursday, July 30 – Joshua 13:1-33**

Can you think of other passages in the Old Testament where the theme of inheritance is important? How does this discussion of the believer's inheritance relate to the church under the new covenant? Take time to thank the Lord for the wonderful inheritance that awaits the people of God.

### **Friday, July 31 – Joshua 14:1-15**

Where do we learn about the figure Caleb in the Old Testament? How does God stay true to his word concerning Caleb? As you consider God's faithfulness to you throughout your life, be sure to give him thanks during your prayer time.

### **Saturday, August 1 – Psalm 149:1-9**

What reason does the Psalmist give as to why the old covenant saints should praise the Lord? How does this truth relate to us under the new covenant? Ask that the Lord would prepare your heart to worship him tomorrow.
