

Bible Reading for the Week of August 9, 2026

Monday, August 10 – John 6:22-40

According to Jesus, why were the crowds seeking after him? What does Jesus desire that they would seek even more than the food he provided in verses 1-15? How might we be tempted toward seeking after the blessings of Christianity without pursuing fellowship and communion with God? Pray that the Lord would cause you to delight, not only in his gifts, but in himself.

Tuesday, August 11 – John 6:22-40

How do these verses offer an interpretation of the miracle of Jesus' feeding of the 5,000? How does Jesus connect his work as the Messiah to God feeding the Israelites in the wilderness? Take time to pray that the Lord would grant you greater faith in Christ.

Wednesday, August 12 – John 6:22-40

John records the first of the 'I am' sayings in his gospel (see vs. 35). What Old Testament passage speaks of God revealing himself as the 'I am.' What is the result of eating this bread which Jesus speaks of? Praise the Lord today for the eternal life he has given you through faith in Jesus.

Thursday, August 13 – Joshua 16:1-17:18

Why does Joshua grant an additional allotment to the tribes of Ephraim and Manasseh? What does this act tell us about Joshua? What must the tribes do to the people of Canaan? Give thanks to the Lord for his faithfulness.

Friday, August 14– Proverbs 31:10-31

Why might the Hebrew Bible have placed the book of Ruth immediately following this passage? How does the character of Ruth exemplify this description in Proverbs.

Saturday, August 15 – Psalm 84:1-12

What is the place that the Psalmist desires to be? Does this desire reside in your own heart? Pray that the Lord, by his Spirit, would prepare your heart to enter into his courts tomorrow.
