

Bible Reading for the Week of September 20, 2026

Monday, September 21 – John 7:25-36

In what way did the people know where Jesus came from? In what way did the people not know where Jesus came from? How does Jesus' relationship to the Father help clarify where he came from? Take time to meditate on the person of Christ, one who possesses a divine and human nature. Give thanks to Christ for His person and work.

Tuesday, September 22 – John 7:25-36

How does the confusion of the Pharisees regarding where Jesus is going reveal the blindness and hardness of their hearts? Do you ever see the blindness and hardness of hearts even among those who profess to be a Christian? Pray that the Spirit of the Lord would keep you from such blindness concerning Christ and his gospel.

Wednesday, September 23 – John 7:25-36

Where is Jesus planning to go? How does this knowledge on the part of Jesus show that he is fully aware of his Messianic calling even during his earthly ministry? Why will the Pharisees not be able to go where Jesus is going? What have we learned so far in John's gospel that enables someone to go where Jesus goes? Praise the Lord today that you have been joined to Jesus Christ by Spirit-wrought faith.

Thursday, September 24 – Joshua 23:1-16

In verse 4, Joshua reminds the people how the Lord had fought for them during Joshua's leadership. How have we seen instances of the Lord fighting for Israel throughout the book? In the light of the coming of Christ, how has the Lord fought for us? Give thanks to the Lord today that He is not only the gentle shepherd of the sheep but the mighty warrior for His people.

Friday, September 25 – Joshua 23:1-16

Throughout this chapter, Joshua commands the people to not only follow the law of the Lord, but to also love the Lord. What is the connection between love and law in the life of the believer? Are these two responses in contradiction? How does the law of God relate to love for God in Romans 13:8-10. Pray that the Lord, by his Spirit, would enable you to love him by keeping His law.

Saturday, September 26 – Joshua 23:1-16

What does Joshua say will happen to Israel if they are faithful in keeping the commands of the Lord? What would happen if they were unfaithful to the commands of the Lord? How does the Lord bless his people for obedience? Pray for the Spirit's working to prepare your heart for worship tomorrow.
