

Bible Reading for the Week of September 6, 2026

Monday, September 7 – Luke 12:13-21

What is the great tragedy of the parable of the rich fool? How might people today be tempted as the rich fool was? Pray that the Lord would give to you contentment in every area of life.

Tuesday, September 8 – Luke 12:22-34

What is the antidote to our worry and anxiety, according to Jesus? How does a knowledge of the heavenly Father's protection serve to alleviate our worry? Pray that the Lord would give you a greater understanding of his protection and provision for you each day.

Wednesday, September 9 – Luke 12:35-48

How should the people of God live before the arrival of Jesus Christ at his second coming? How might it change your life if you knew Christ was returning today? Would you change anything? Pray for wisdom in order to pursue the Lord's purposes as we wait for our blessed hope.

Thursday, September 10 – Joshua 22:1-9

What were the two and a half tribes on the east of the Jordan required to do for the rest of the people of God? How does this demonstrate the importance of unity among the people of God? How might the church grow in her unity? How might you grow in your unity with other brothers and sisters in the church? Pray that the Spirit of wisdom and unity would be given to you in greater fullness.

Friday, September 11 – Joshua 22:10-34

Why would it have been such a heinous sin for the tribes east of the Jordan to erect an altar to the Lord? Why must God only be worshiped in the way that he had prescribed in his word? Take time to pray for a greater love and heart for the true worship of God.

Saturday, September 12 – James 2:1-13

What is the sin in view here in this section? How might the sin of partiality still plague the church today? Pray that the Spirit would prepare your heart today for the worship of God tomorrow on the Lord's Day.
